reconstruction combines very sensitively the original historical features – sandstone architraves, window replicas, the original main entrance door etc. with modern architectonic features. Modern materials were used in the construction of the extension – glass, aluminium, steel and stone; for example the wall tiling of the facade is made of Chinese granite. The most interesting part of the extension is the glazed gallery, about 35 m long. The interior of the building is very contemporary; it emphasizes primarily illumination and open space and uses particularly glass, steel and...
