

Hořovice Hospital – New Building for the Surgery



The new surgery building is connected to the existing main building with a three-storey glazed block. The building has one underground and four above-ground storeys, a concrete-steel monolithic skeleton and peripheral walls. For greater variability, inner partitions are made of plaster boards. A contact heat-insulation system combined with aerated facade with cembonite wall tiling on the rounded part of the annex was chosen for the facade of the building. All vertical communication spaces in the building (staircases, lifts) are located in this part. The staircase area is designed very attractively in terms of architecture - dented stair flights which are connected to the peripheral jacket dominate in a large open space. The new building also houses central sterilisation, X-ray and anaes...
