Shared innovation

The centre preserves original architecture to a substantial extent including the historical style of façades as well as the unusual dominant feature, the brewery chimney. The shopping centre consists of 1 underground and 4 aboveground floors housing more than 100 retail units, a multi-screen cinema and 500 parking spaces. The usable floor area totals 56,090 m2 including 26,100 m2 of leasable area. The newbuild part (upper and lower courtyard, connecting link, former plant room premises) features a cast-in-place concrete skeletal frame reinforced with communication cores, and pile foundations. The roofing systems of the new buildings are flat with waterproofing membranes; open-space malls are glazed. The façades are composed of ventilated systems with a visible layer of expanded metal...
