

# The Consulate General of the Czech Republic in Munich



The building's layout strictly differentiates areas for the public from the representative premises on the ground floor. The first and second floor house offices and separate residences. The entire ground area has a basement located underneath and secures technical base, stocks and garages. Both entrances into the consulate general building are wheelchair accessible. The main vertical communications section within the height of the entire building is formed by a single staircase and a personal lift. The building's load bearing structure is made of monolithic steel-concrete walls, pillars and monolithic ceiling boards. The building sits on a steel-concrete foundation slab, which also runs under part of the garage entrance. All surfaces are made of solid traditional building material...
